

## Applying to the University of Melbourne Graduate Entry Medical Program

(**PLEASE NOTE:** students are now eligible to apply to the University of Melbourne's Graduate Entry Medical program using the University's application form via OzTREKK, and **DO NOT** have to apply via ACER.)

### Entry requirements:

- \* Graduate Entry Program for students who are completing the final year of an approved three or more year university degree or who are graduates.
- \* Pre-requisite program/studies: Bachelor's degree in any area of study and the completion of MCAT
- \* Undergraduate Degree Cumulative Average necessary: 65%
- \* MCAT requirement: no minimum requirement other than a 'P' in the essay section. However, the Faculty does recommend that students have an overall MCAT of around a 30 to be competitive.
- \* Interview: held via telephone between October and November

### Who Should Apply

Student who have a weighted GPA of 75% and above and an MCAT score of 30P and above are strongly encouraged to apply. Those with a weighted GPA below 75% and/or an MCAT below 30P should contact OzTREKK for alternate options.

### Application Fee

There is a \$100 AUD application fee to apply to the University of Melbourne and is payable by all international student wishing to apply to the University.

### Application Deadline

The application deadline is Friday, June 27, 2008.
